Subject: Weather Conditions over North West India

Current Weather Situations

- A western disturbance as a trough at 3.1km above mean sea level runs roughly along Long 62°E to the north of Lat 32°N. This Western Disturbance is likely to affect North-west India during the period 8th to 12th December 2018. Due to the interaction of the Western Disturbance with easterly/south easterly winds, some moisture incursion will take place over plains of north west India from 9th December onwards.

Warning and Weather Forecast for next 7 days:

- Scattered to Fairly wide spread precipitation with isolated heavy rain/snow is likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir during 8th to 12th December 2018.
- Light rain/ snow would occur at a few places over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand during 9th to 12th December.
- Isolated to scattered Light rain/thundershowers would also occur over the plains of North west India except Rajasthan during 10th to 11th December 2018.

Weather Forecast for Delhi NCR:

- Light rain at isolated places over Delhi NCR on 11th December 2018.
- Winds of the order of 8-10 kmph are likely with Easterly/South easterly component from 9th evening to 12th December 2018.
- North-Westerly winds of the order of 6-8 kmph from 14th December 2018 onwards.
