



All India Weather Warning Bulletin

Wednesday 12 December 2018
Time of Issue: 2000 hours IST

(NIGHT)

12 December (Day 1): ♦ **Dense fog** at isolated places is very likely over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh.

♦ Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial Indian ocean. Sea condition likely to be rough to very rough. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

13 December (Day 2): ♦ **Dense fog** at isolated places is very likely over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and Uttar Pradesh.

♦ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph very likely over central parts of south Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial Indian ocean. Sea condition likely to be rough to very rough. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

14 December (Day 3): ♦ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to commence along & off south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north Tamilnadu & Puducherry coasts from 15th December morning. Fishermen in deep sea are advised to return to the coast.

♦ Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph very likely over southwest Bay of Bengal. Sea condition likely to be rough to very rough. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

15 December (Day 4): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rain at isolated places likely over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north coastal Tamilnadu.

♦ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to commence along & off south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north Tamilnadu & Puducherry coasts from morning.

♦ Gale wind wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph likely over southwest and adjoining west central Bay of Bengal. Sea condition likely to be very rough to high. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

16 December (Day 5): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rain at isolated places likely over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north coastal Tamilnadu.

♦ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely along & off south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north Tamilnadu & Puducherry coasts.

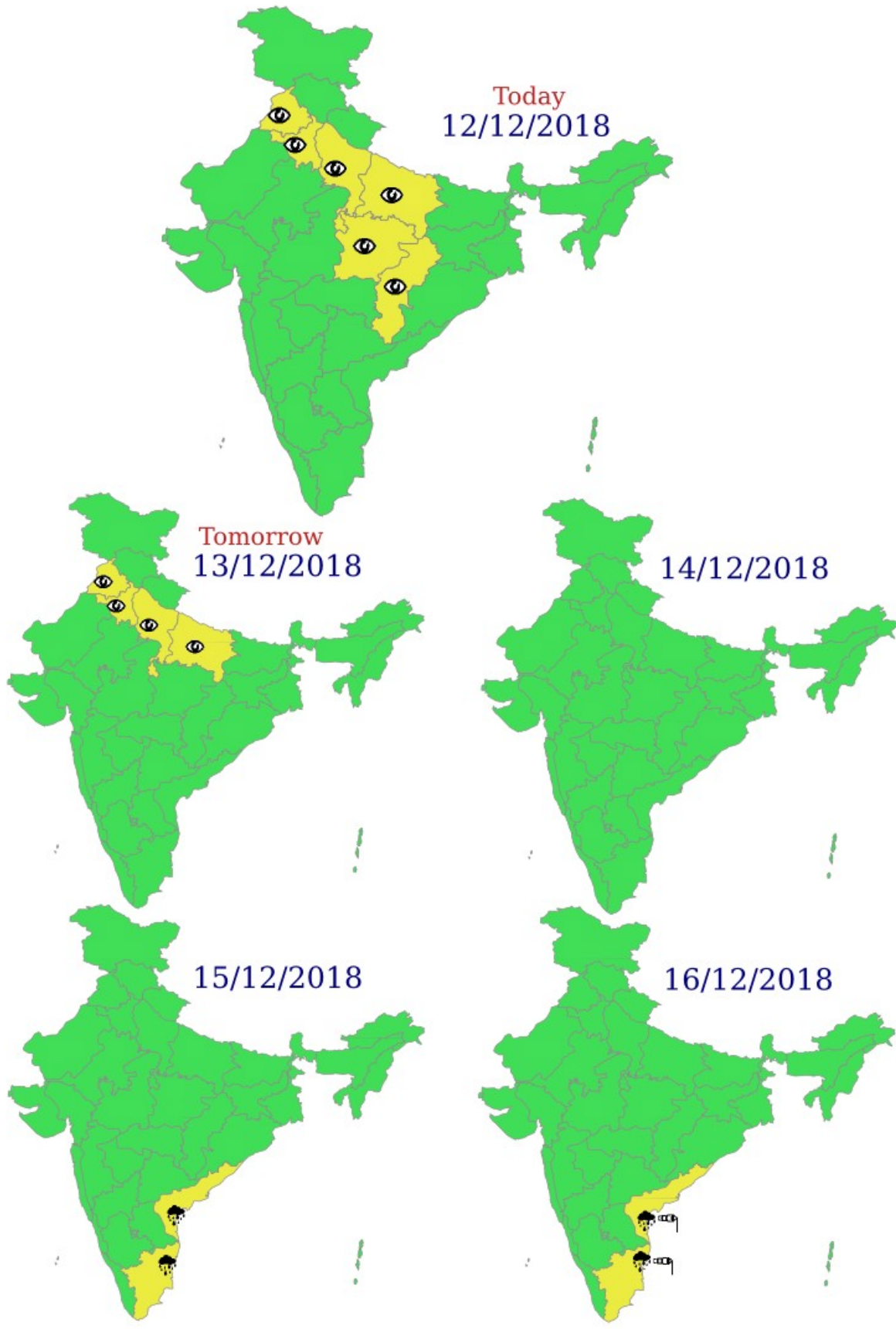
♦ Gale wind wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph likely over west central and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal. Sea condition likely to be very rough to high. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

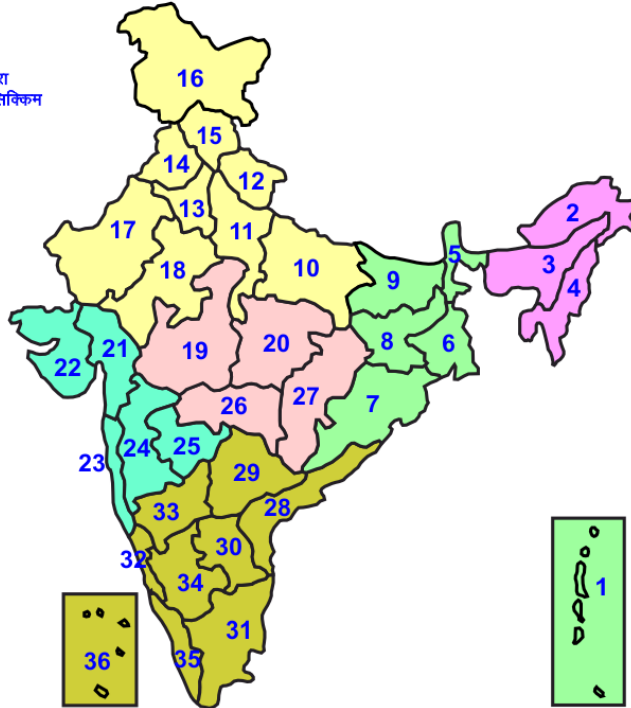
